# Process

- ❖ A total of 8 responses representing 8 organizations and 15 respondents (Ethiopia, India, Kenya, Nepal, Nigeria, Senegal, IIRR and ETC)
- ❖ Usual topics:
  1. Network governance, Learning, sharing of information, International capacity building, Functioning of the IST and the Secretariat, Increased international awareness on PID/Prolinnova;
  2. Country self- assessment

# Summary assessment

<b>Governance 3.35 (3.6)</b>	<b>Learning, sharing of info 2.66 (2.75)</b>
<b>Capacity building 2.62 (2.04)</b>	<b>Functioning of the IST and the Secretariat 3.05 (3.28)</b>
<b>Increased international awareness 3.07 (3.48)</b>	<b>Self assessment 2.45 (3.16)</b>

# Findings:

- ❖ Little communication/information from **POG**, perceived to be less active; because of less funding or less issues to handle?
- ❖ **Sharing** through website and yahogroup fine but little participation of partners in int conferences and meetings.
- ❖ No international **capacity building** events, limited backstopping; despite funding constraints, IST designed meaningful IPWs

# Findings

- ❖ **IST/Secretariat** support less visible, less fund raising (except 2 regional projects); need support from IST e.g. in Planning and Monitoring
- ❖ **Increased international interest** and changes noted by ITS but CPs less positive

# CP Self assessment

- Quite a few CPs face challenges (host, secretariat)
- Those involved in Regional projects have kept Prolinnova network alive
- Efforts to keep partners hampered by lack of funds
