



## Prolinnova–Cambodia annual report on activities in 2022

### Introduction

The national non-governmental organisation (NGO) Community Developer Organisation (CDO) leads Prolinnova–Cambodia as the host organisation after it was selected through a consultative process in dialogues at country and international level.

CDO is committed to work with governmental institutions, researchers, agricultural advisors and farmers in order to build strong relationships between and among them. CDO currently works closely with four institutions representing provincial-level Departments of Agriculture and Cooperatives.

The new National Steering Committee (NSC) was elected during the a Working Group meeting of Prolinnova–Cambodia on 17 February 2022. The NSC has five members (4 male, 1 female) from the Community Developer Organization (CDO), the Provincial Department of Agriculture, Fisheries Prey Veng (PDA-Prey Veng), the Kampong Cham National Institution of Agriculture (KCNIA) and Cambodia Agriculture Cooperative Unions (CACU). The NSC acts as governance body.

### Achievements

Prolinnova–Cambodia took an active role in Prolinnova-related activities – including in drafting the concept note *Asia–Africa cross-learning* submitted to Misereor. The members carry out these activities through their organisations’ projects at country level, and normally communicate through mail and virtual meetings. After CDO took over as the host organisation following a couple of years’ gap, it has been actively involved in working with multiple stakeholders though these projects and making efforts to integrate PID concepts into the processes. However, the CP has not been documenting how the members have incorporated Prolinnova-related activities into their projects in specific terms.

The table below shows the self-assessment of Prolinnova–Cambodia members in various network functions; this indicates an average performance overall.
